## Hanover-Ahlem (A12)

From late November 1944 to 6 April 1945, 750 Jewish prisoners had to fortify an asphalt tunnel at the Niedersachsen Engineering Works in Hanover-Ahlem. The arms production of Continental-Gummiwerke AG and Maschinenwerke Niedersachsen was to be moved into this underground tunnel. The men were housed in fenced-off barracks on the grounds of the Continental factory.
