## Hamburg-Eidelstedt

Eidelstedt satellite camp for women existed between 27 September 1944 and April 1945 in several huts on Friedrichshulder Weg. 500 Czech and Hungarian Jewish women from Auschwitz-Birkenau extermination camp had been brought to the camp via the Dessauer Ufer and Wedel satellite camps. They worked in constructing provisional housing from prefabricated concrete slabs, and they cleared rubble and snow from the streets of Hamburg.


## Aerial Photograph from 1945
