Lütjenburg-Hohwacht

Between December 1944 and 19 April 1945, 200 men were forced to make precision compasses for the Kiel firm Anschütz & Co. in Lütjenburg-Hohwacht. These compasses were used for the V2 rocket, among other things. The prisoners, most of them highly skilled experts, were housed in air force barracks on the shore of the Baltic sea.
