

Salzgitter-Drütte

Between 13 October 1942 and 7 April 1945, up to 3,000 men in the Drütte satellite camp were forced to produce shells for the state-owned "Hermann Göring" factory. Drütte was thus the largest Neuengamme satellite camp apart from Bremen-Farge. The prisoners' blocks were located underneath an overpass for the factory's freight traffic.
