Félix Lazare Bertrand, who was imprisoned in the camp section for "prominent prisoners" from France, was one of the few prisoners in Neuengamme concentration camp who had the opportunity to draw. In this drawing, he probably captured the arrival or the departure of a woman forced to work as a prostitute. 1944/45.
