

Defeated Republican Units



In the Spanish Civil War, General Franco, who was supported by Hitler, defeated the armies fighting for the Spanish Republic. In 1939, after the war, many of the remaining Republican units fled over the border to France, where they were disarmed and interned by the French police. The majority of these Spanish Republicans stayed in France for the rest of their lives. Many continued fighting in France, this time against the German occupation.
